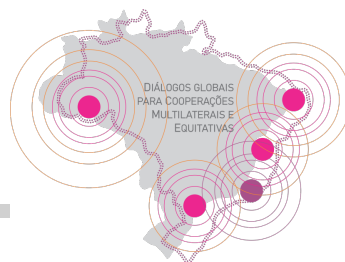

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE CAPES-GLOBALE.U EDU POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP IN BRAZIL

Within the framework of the Network “GLOBAL DIALOGUES FOR MULTILATERAL AND EQUITABLE COOPERATION”

1. Introduction

Pursuant to CAPES-GLOBAL.EDU Call No. 13/2025, the Graduate Program in Pharmacology and Medicinal Chemistry (PPGFQM), Institute of Biomedical Sciences, Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRJ), hereby invites applications for one (01) Postdoctoral Fellowship in Brazil under the CAPES-Global.edu Program.

Applications will be accepted from June 10, 2026, through June 22, 2026, in accordance with the internal deadlines established by the Network Management Committee.

The fellowship shall have a duration of 180 days (six months), commencing between March and April 2027 and ending between August and September 2027.

The Selection Committee appointed by PPGFQM shall be responsible for evaluating applications and reviewing all documentation required by CAPES, in compliance with the rules and procedures established by the funding agency.

Only applications for which receipt of documentation has been formally acknowledged by email shall be considered valid.

1.1. Fellowship Modality

Postdoctoral Fellowship in Brazil

Duration: 6 months (renewable up to a maximum of 36 months within the duration of the Network activities, subject to funding availability and CAPES regulations).

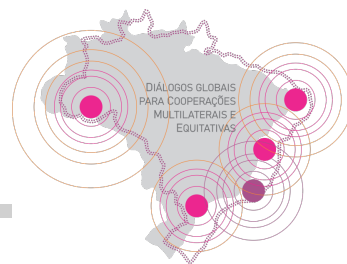
This fellowship modality aims to attract Brazilian and international researchers residing abroad who possess significant academic and scientific experience acquired outside Brazil, including completion of a full doctoral degree and/or postdoctoral training abroad for a minimum period of twelve (12) months.

- Monthly Fellowship Stipend.

2. Eligibility Requirements

2.1 Reside abroad.

2.2 Hold a Brazilian Individual Taxpayer Registration Number (CPF).

2.3 Have relevant academic and scientific experience abroad, including a full PhD or postdoctoral training lasting at least twelve months.

3. Required documentation

Documents may be submitted in either Portuguese or English.

- Curriculum Vitae.
- Updated ORCID record.
- Proof of completion of a PhD degree or postdoctoral training at a foreign higher education and/or research institution for a minimum period of twelve months.
- Proof of residence abroad.
- Copy of CPF (if unavailable, it must be obtained by July 21, 2026).
- Copy of passport valid for at least six months beyond the intended stay.
- Child's birth certificate (for applicants who became mothers through childbirth or adoption within the last five years).

Work Plan:

- Identification of a supervisor who is a permanent faculty member of PPGFQM.
- Description of research, teaching, training, lectures, seminars, or related activities.
- Justification demonstrating relevance, timeliness, and alignment with PPGFQM research lines and UFRJ's Institutional Internationalization Project.
- Clear definition of the study object(s).
- Objectives and goals.
- Timeline.
- Contribution to education, training, learning, and international cooperation.
- Information on compliance with ethical regulations, when applicable.
- Description of additional academic activities.
- References.
- Expected outcomes.

4. Application procedures

Applications must be submitted by e-mail between June 10 and June 22, 2026, at 11:59 PM.

All documents listed above must be attached in PDF format, with one file corresponding to each document.

Incomplete, missing, or illegible documentation will result in disqualification.

5. SELECTION AND RANKING

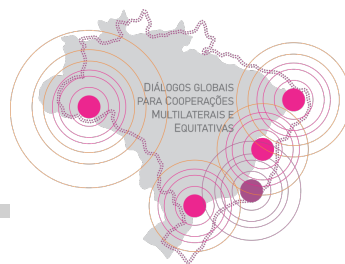
The Evaluation Committee shall consist of the Program Coordinator (or Deputy Coordinator), two PPGFQM faculty members, two external faculty members, and one doctoral student representative.

Selection criteria:

- a) Compliance with CAPES requirements;
- b) Adequacy of submitted documentation;
- c) Candidate qualifications and scientific merit of the proposal;
- d) Feasibility of the proposed work plan;
- e) Adequacy of the host institution;

- f) Academic merit of the proposed supervisor and research project;
- g) Curriculum analysis, emphasizing scientific output in Biological Sciences II;
- h) Potential for strengthening international cooperation and exchanges;
- i) Priority for candidates who have not previously benefited from a postdoctoral fellowship outside the country where they obtained their doctoral degree;
- j) Promotion of equity, diversity, and affirmative actions;
- k) Compensatory measure for applicants who became mothers within the previous five years, through application of a correction factor to the curriculum score, limited to the maximum score allowed.

6. Results

The final results shall be approved by the Graduate Program Board and published according to the schedule below.

Candidates will be listed in descending order of ranking.

The allocation of fellowships remains subject to confirmation by the PPGFQM coordination.

7. Appeals
